## DRONE DEMONSTRATION

Catch an exciting drone demonstration in the **Horticulture** section throughout the day!

### Fun Facts about the T50 Drone!

- The drone uses 8 propellers
- The controller has a bright 7-inch touchscreen display, almost like flying with a giant tablet
- This drone can carry up to 40 litres of liquid spray or 50kg of granules
- Can spray crops at a rate of up to 24 litres per minute with the optional four-sprinkler setup
- It can cover approximately 21 hectares in one hour, that's about 40 footy ovals every hour!
- It can automatically follow the shape of hills and uneven terrain with terrain-following technology
- When fully loaded, the drone can weigh over 100kg at take-off – heavier than a full-grown kangaroo!

Step into the past and explore the history of our College. Here you'll find photos, stories, and moments that have shaped life at Harvey Ag over the years.

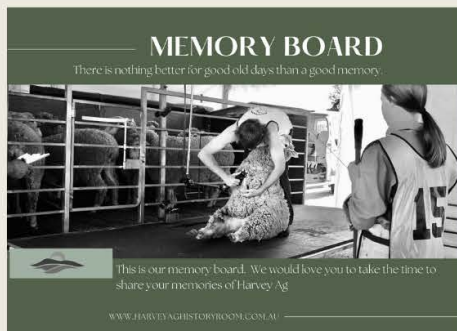
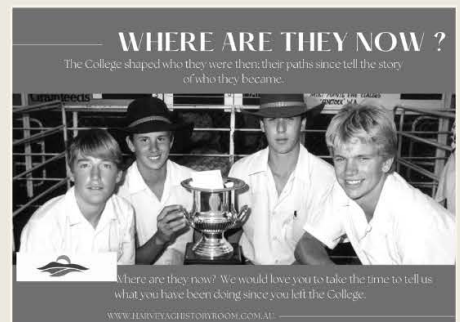

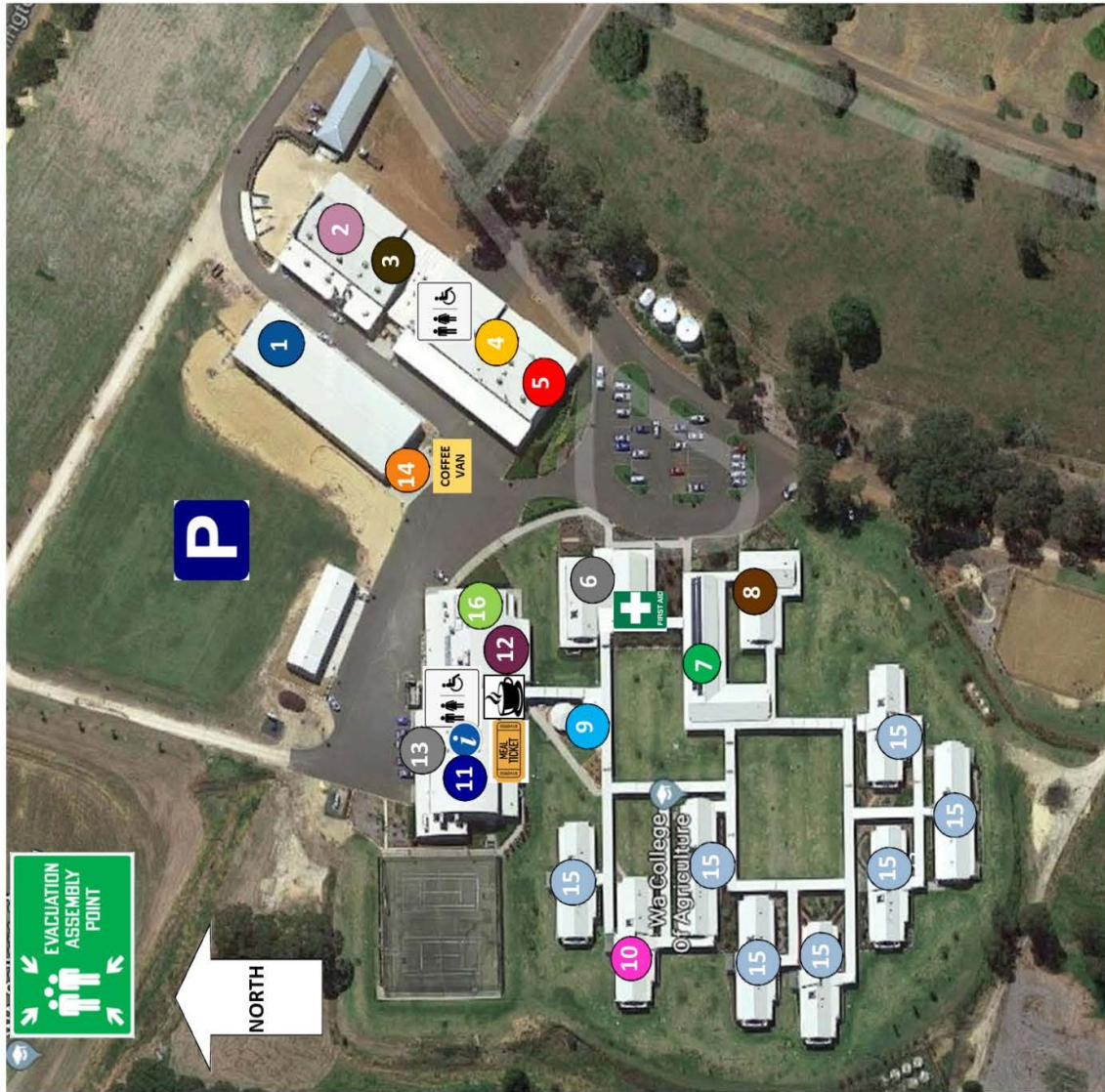
